Things You Should Know

- Consignment arrangements are extremely time-consuming and too often fraught with personal sensitivities. Therefore, it is our preference to source our inventory directly from publishers, distributors, or wholesalers, such as Ingram. If your book is available in any of these ways, at the industry standard discount of 40% or better and is *returnable*, we will purchase it directly should we wish to stock it.
- Our focus in regard to the limited number of titles we can accept on consignment is greater Addison County: its resident authors or subject matter pertaining to our specific community.
- If your book meets this most basic criteria, we will review it carefully for quality, relevance, and commercial viability.
- Should we offer you a consignment contract, your book will be shelved in our local authors section at the front of the store. Merchandising specifics are at our discretion.
- Our contract does not include any individual marketing or event services. If we wish to hold an event with you or feature your book on our website or social media accounts, we will let you know.
- Under the terms of the contract, you assume all risk of loss, theft, or damage. At the contract termination date, we will pay you according to our verifiable sales data.
- Any remaining books must be retrieved within 60 days from contract termination. After that, they will be donated or destroyed without any additional notice.
